SOME OF OUR HIGHLIGHTS INCLUDE:

- A reduction in our CO2 tonnes baseline year 2009/10 of 22%
- A reduction in our overall gas consumption of 11% and electric by 10% in comparison to our baseline year
- Reduction in our overall electric consumption of 1% and water consumption by 12% in comparison to the previous year
- An impressive 10% reduction in our water utility costs in comparison to the previous year
- Two of our previous heating and lighting refurbishment projects continue to make excellent annual carbon and financial reductions in excess of £20k per annum and savings of 100 CO2 tonnes.
- Other financial savings made include ongoing VAT reductions on both gas and electricity invoices as per Inland Revenue specified exemptions for student accommodation and R & D areas, renewal of contracts, researching and obtaining best rates for the next 12-month period, routine maintenance replacement / changing of equipment / products as and when needed
- We continue to add and review future planned projects as per the Carbon Management Plan. Priority to be given to electricity carbon reduction projects and concentration on exceeding 3% annual carbon tonnes reduction target to ensure 2020 target met
