

ROLE OF DATA PROTECTION OFFICER

Wrexham Glyndŵr University is required to nominate one or more Data Protection supervisors to oversee University compliance with the Data Protection Act 1998 (as amended).

In accordance with the GDPR, Article 37 states that ‘the Data Protection Officer shall be designated on the basis of professional qualities and in particular, expert knowledge of data protection law and practices and the ability to fulfil the tasks referred to in Article 39.’
