Photoshop courses are in two main levels: Beginners and Advanced. These courses will prepare you on both academic and professional levels to use Photoshop software to plan, develop, and integrate bitmap photographs and images in creative practice. This advanced course prepares you for the Adobe Certified Associate (ACA) exam through advanced hands-on tips and techniques. You will be introduced to the ACA exam, cover its different aspects, and break the ice through several practical questions. This track (Essential and Advanced levels) will help you put your creative ideas into action by integrating advanced theory and practice into tasks that prepare you for your future career in digital graphics.
